As a way of Creating Connections, several conference sessions have been planned as *State Agency Panel Discussions* so that state agency staff can share resources, learn how the CACFP is administered in other states, and make connections with CACFP professionals in other state agencies.

NPA is looking for presenters to participate in one or more *State Agency Panel Discussions* and we are hoping you or a member of your staff will be willing to participate and share the wealth of information your state agency has to offer.

Below are the State Agency Panel Discussion topics:

**Recordkeeping:** Recordkeeping systems for various CACFP areas and requirements including infants, productions records, special diets, meal pattern components/items (yogurt, cereal, whole grain rich).

**Monitoring Meal Production:** Required tools/forms to demonstrate how much food is prepared at programs; system of how your state agency monitors programs to determine enough food was purchased and prepared; and when your state agency disallows meals that do not meal the meal pattern.

**Corrective Action Plans:** Assessing, reviewing and monitoring corrective action, including forms/systems used.

**SO Unaffiliated:** Monitoring of sponsors of unaffiliated centers, including budget and application process and administrative evaluations.

**Financial Management:** Process for monitoring of an institutions' financial management processes, including budget, nonprofit food service, allowable costs, and 15% administrative costs.

**Serious Deficiency:** Serious deficiency process including the termination and appeal process.

Each presenter should plan on 20-30 minutes of presenting with additional time for questions.
