Subject: 2021 CACFP National Professional Association Conference

The biennial CACFP National Professional Association (NPA) Conference will be held virtually, July 13 – 15, 2021.

The conference offers an opportunity for State Agency staff responsible for administering the CACFP to receive training on implementation of the meal pattern, gain the latest updates on Federal policies and requirements and engage State agency colleagues in meaningful discussions about Program issues and opportunities.

The conference will cover a range of important topics related to the CACFP and examine how State administrators can respond to the challenges of delivering a quality Program. U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA), Institute of Child Nutrition (ICN), Food Research & Action Center (FRAC) and MH Miles staff will be present throughout the conference.

Topics to be addressed at the conference include:
